About Hong Kong Ice Hockey Association

Hong Kong Ice Hockey Association (HKIHA), currently registered as HongKong Ice Hockey Association Limited, was established in 1980. It primarily aspires to have better management, development and promotion of ice hockey in Hong Kong. HKIHA is a full member of the International Ice Hockey Federation (IIHF) and an associate member of the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China (SF & OC). As a National Sports Association, Hong Kong Ice Hockey Association (HKIHA) is able to receive subventions from the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) to provide various programs that help the development of ice hockey in Hong Kong.

In the role of the national sports association for ice hockey in Hong Kong, the goal of HKIHA is to promote both ice hockey and inline hockey in Hong Kong and Asia. HKIHA provides training sessions to their players, development programs to youth and adult players as well as officials and coaches, and organize all levels of competitions for players in accordance with the international ice hockey rules and regulations.

Every year, HKIHA allows their youth and adult players, coaches and game officials to participate in the IIHF camps as well as the Asian Development camps to help their participants develop, train and improve their skills and continue to reach and partake in higher levels of competition. HKIHA also oversees the three national teams - the Hong Kong Senior Men's National Team, the Hong Kong Senior Women's National Team and the Hong Kong U18 Men's National Team, all of which compete in the IIHF World Championship program.

2014-2015 Hong Kong Women's Ice Hockey League HKWIHL



In the season 2013-2014, a new Women' s only league was created called the Hong Kong Women' s Ice Hockey League (HKWIHL) beginning from September 2013 to April 2014, the first ever international rules complied women' s league competition in Hong Kong. This is also one of the few local sports event catering to women as participants and audience. This league is open to all female players in Hong Kong.

The league' s goal is not only setting the ground work for consistent player development but also projecting the image of "empowerment to women" in the competition. In addition to games, there will be monthly team practices which are structured and executed by coaches specific to each team. HKWIHL aims at being a training ground and part of a feeder system for the Hong Kong Women' s National Team which is now eligible for IIHF World Championship Competition. The League is held at Mega Ice, Kowloon Bay from October to April. It is hosted by Hong Kong Ice Hockey Association (HKIHA), with Women' s Ice Hockey Organization (WIHO) and Hong Kong Amateur Hockey Club (HKAHC) as the co-organizers.

2014-2015 Hong Kong Youth Ice Hockey League (HKYIHL) U15 Division



This year was Hong Kong Youth Ice Hockey League's (HKYIHL) first season. There were three divisions (U8/U10, U12 and U15) with four teams in each division – Gold Club, Empire Skate, Hong Kong Academy of Ice Hockey (HKAIH) and HKIHA. All players attended tryouts and based on results, players were drafted into the four different teams. The league, which is subvented by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD), aims to provide a competitive league for youth ice hockey players in Hong Kong to develop and grow as part of the junior national team development plan. The best players of the HKYIHL were then selected into the Junior Feeder Program for further training and development.

Players attended the Hong Kong Youth Ice Hockey League's (HKYIHL) evaluation and tryout camp that was held during the end of September to October 2014. The tryouts consisted of fundamental drills that focused on skating, passing and shooting. These drills were timed and each player's final result was used to draft the players onto each team.

Approximately 40 players were selected per division to maintain an elite standard within the league. This was done to allow talented players and the best players within their age group to compete amongst each other for more competitive games.

The HKYIHL played its first game in October 2014 and concluded with playoffs in April 2015.

About the Junior Feeder Program

The Junior Feeder Program, also known as the Junior National Team Development Program, is a training program designed to help youth hockey players develop their skills that will one day help them reach their full potential. The Feeder Program consists of the best players within their age group and can only be selected to participate through tryouts and an evaluation process. These 2 processes are done based on the first tryouts and their performance in the Hong Kong Youth Ice Hockey League. By maintaining a high standard with top talents, the Feeder Program allows a chance for elite players to practice and compete with each other to allow further progress and development.

With years of experience from competing in regional to international tournaments, these player coaches can use this opportunity to get involved with the development of Hong Kong hockey and give back to the community. Furthermore, they can pass on their skills and knowledge to the next generation of players.

With more players coming through Feeder Program, HKIHA hopes more players will expand to other areas of ice hockey including coaching, officiating and other development areas to grow ice hockey in Hong Kong.
